

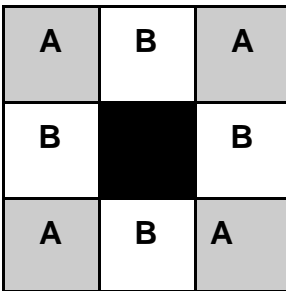
Join the OQ Quilts for Soldiers Project!

Send us a block - or two or three, or a whole stack! Blocks will be assembled into quilts to be given to injured soldiers from Ohio. **Bring your blocks to the Annual Meeting** or mail to our post office box. These will be scrap quilts made with red, white, and blue fabrics. Please use good quality pre-washed COTTON fabric. The quilts could be subjected to some rough treatment in industrial laundry facilities, so we need to start with good materials! Many blue and red fabrics bleed -- please be sure to pre-wash your fabric. Blue and red fabrics can be values from medium to dark. A variety of fabrics will be fine for a scrappy look.

The block couldn't be much simpler -- we're using 9-patch blocks. For each block, you will need:

- Fabric A - 4 5½" squares blue
- Fabric B - 4 5½" squares off-white - light beige
- Fabric C - 1 5½" square red

Piece a 9-patch block, making sure fabrics A, B, and C are in **exactly** the same place as the illustration. Please press seams away from fabric B in all rows.
